New Diagnoses

IN THE UNITED STATES IN 2017:

21% of all new HIV diagnoses were among young people aged 13-24

87% of those were young men

93% of those young men were infected by a same-sex partner

Infection Rates by Population

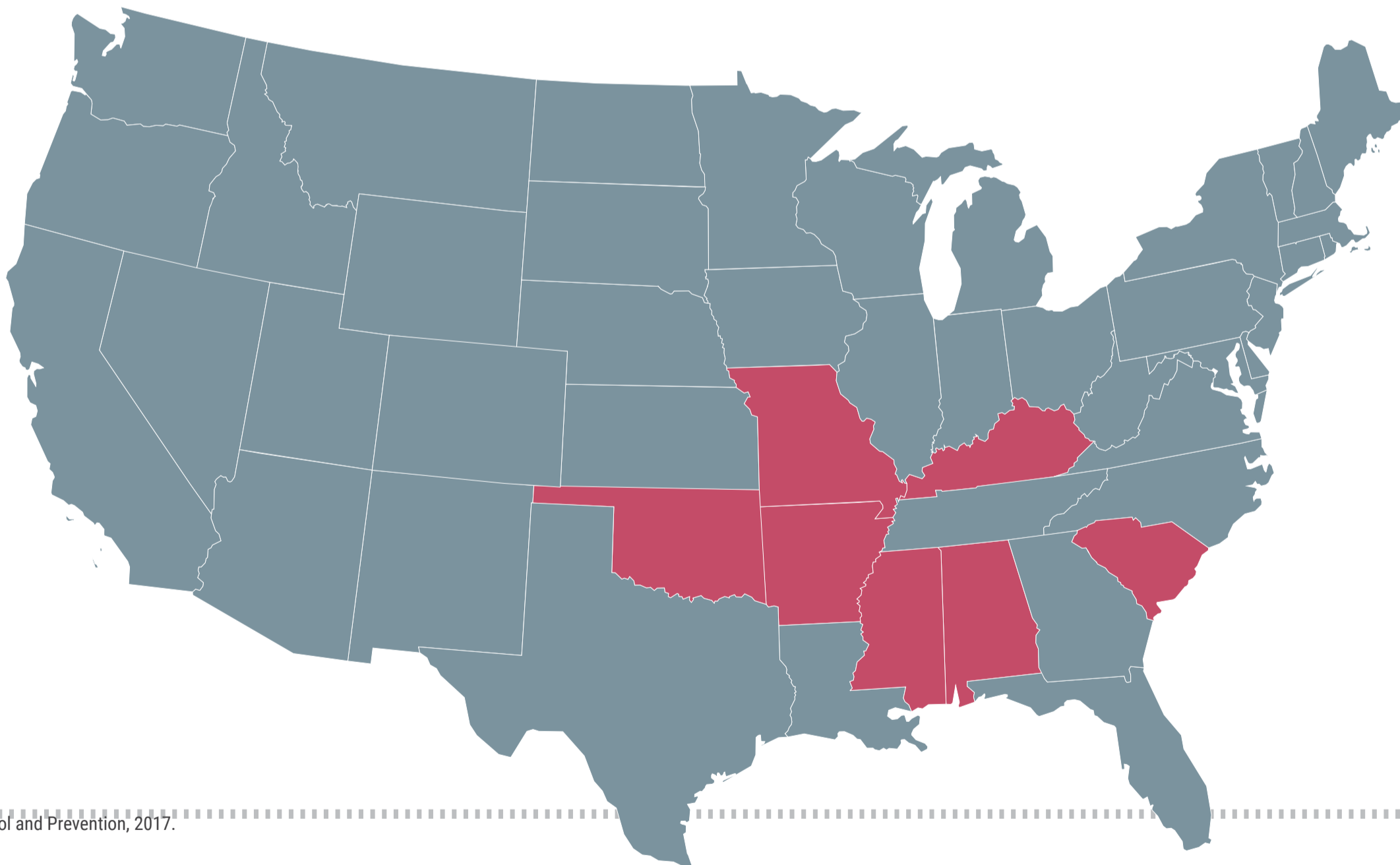
Black MSM Overrepresented Among Newly Diagnosed Gay/ Bisexual Male Patients
