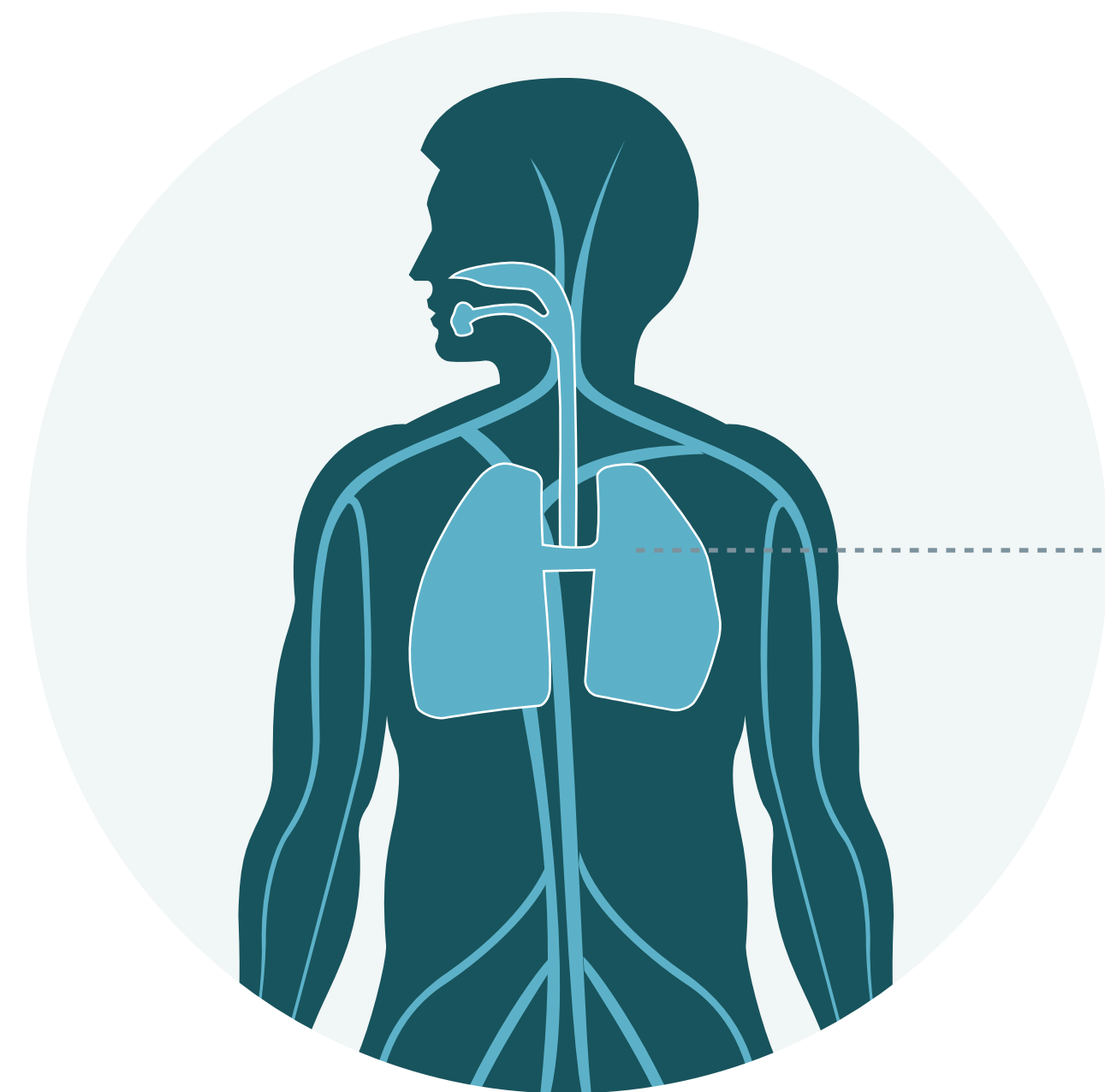

The Damage From Secondhand Smoke



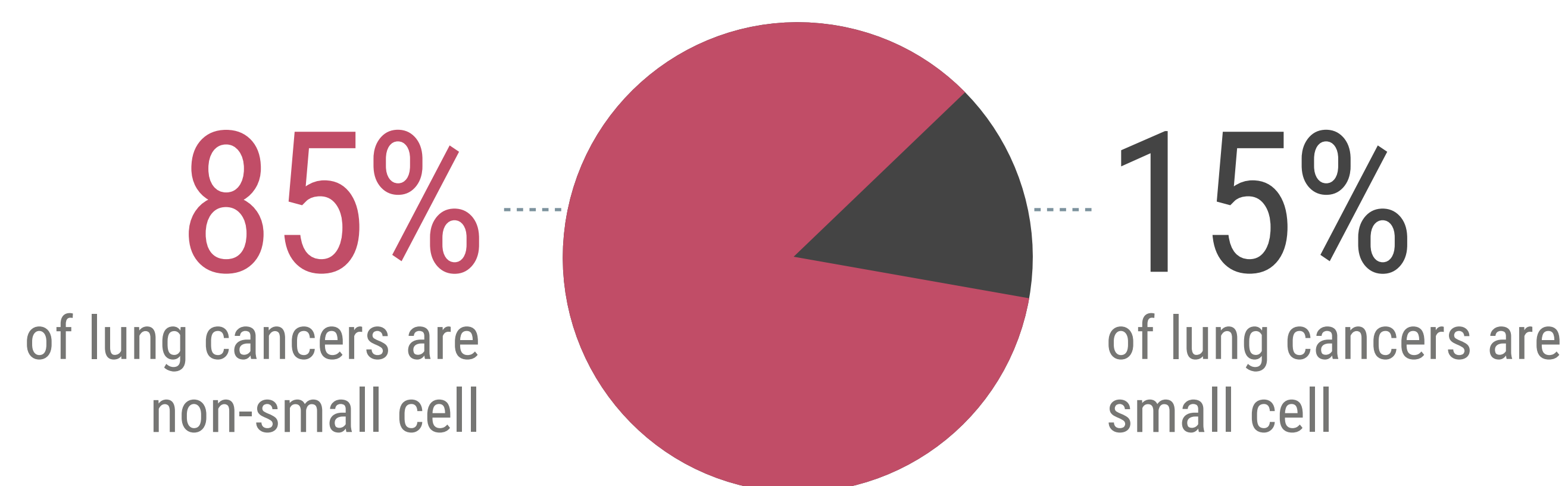
Exposure to secondhand smoke
