

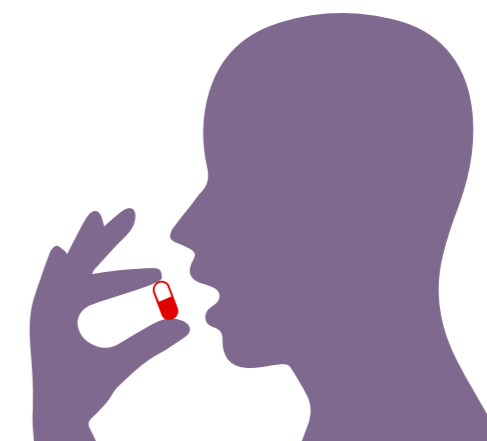

Efficacy of Second-Line Therapies



60% - 70% OF ITP PATIENTS will require second-line therapies

Splenectomy

70%-80% response rate

Thrombopoietin receptor agonists (TPO-RAs)

80% response rate

Rituximab (Monoclonal antibody)

70% response rate
