

OBJECTIVE

To assess adult patient perspectives and experiences in the care of their attention-deficit hyperactivity disorder (ADHD).



METHODS

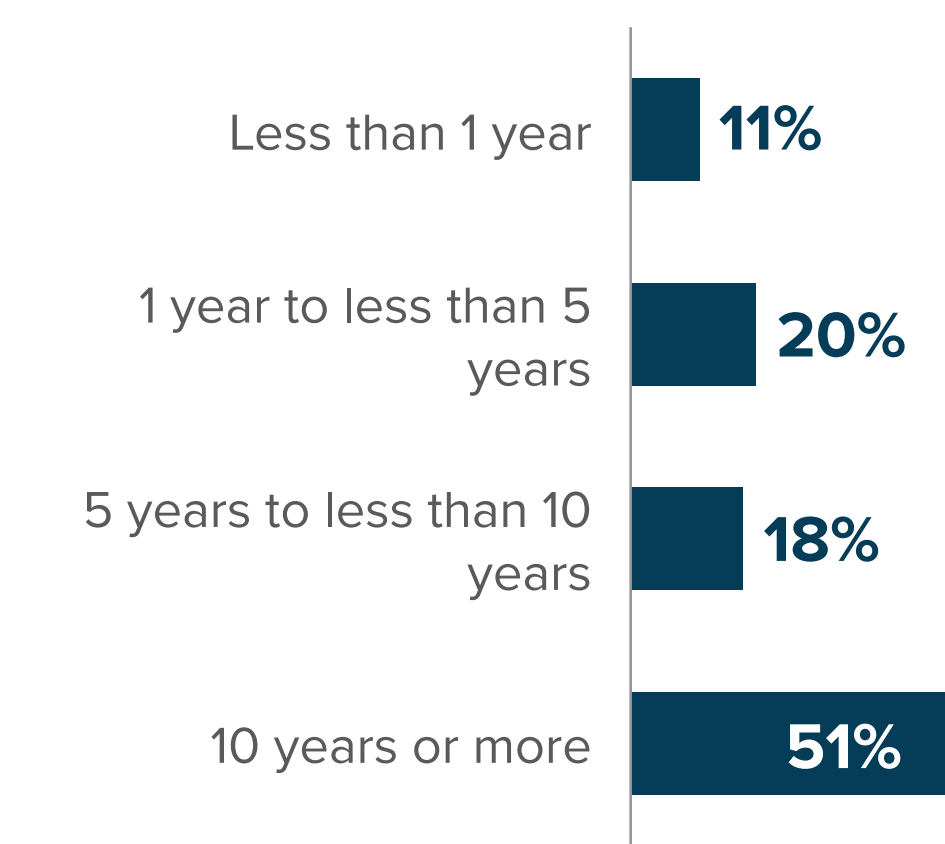
A 20-question, online, patient-facing survey was deployed on WebMD.com. No personally identifiable information was collected for the respondents in this study. Initial data collection occurred from November 6, 2023 to November 10, 2023.



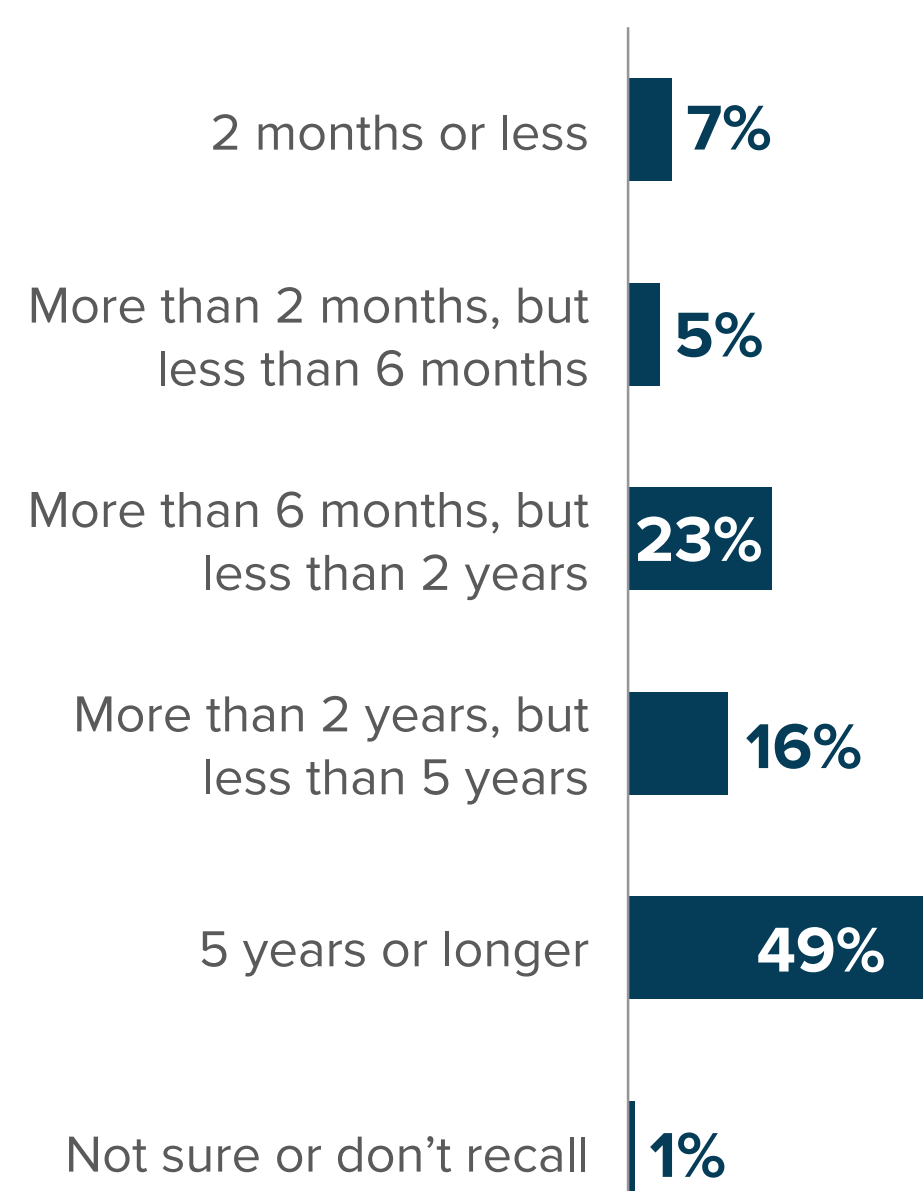
RESULTS

In total, **318 individuals** completed the survey (92% diagnosed with adult ADHD). Majority of respondents had ADHD for more than 10 years and been on medication for more than 5 years.

HOW MANY YEARS AGO WERE YOU/THE PERSON YOU CARE FOR DIAGNOSED WITH ADHD?

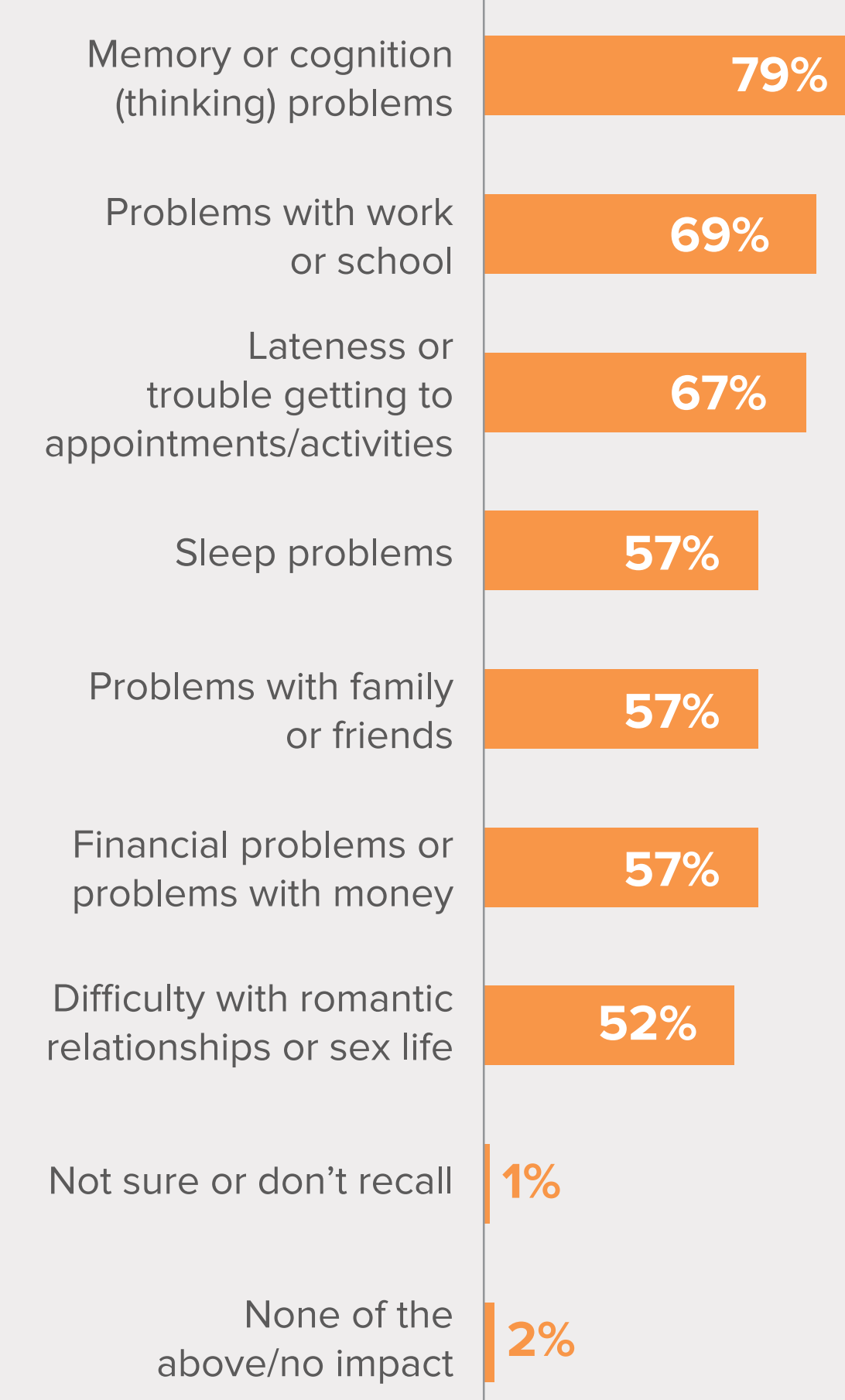


HOW LONG HAS MEDICINE AS TREATMENT FOR ADHD BEEN GIVEN FOR?



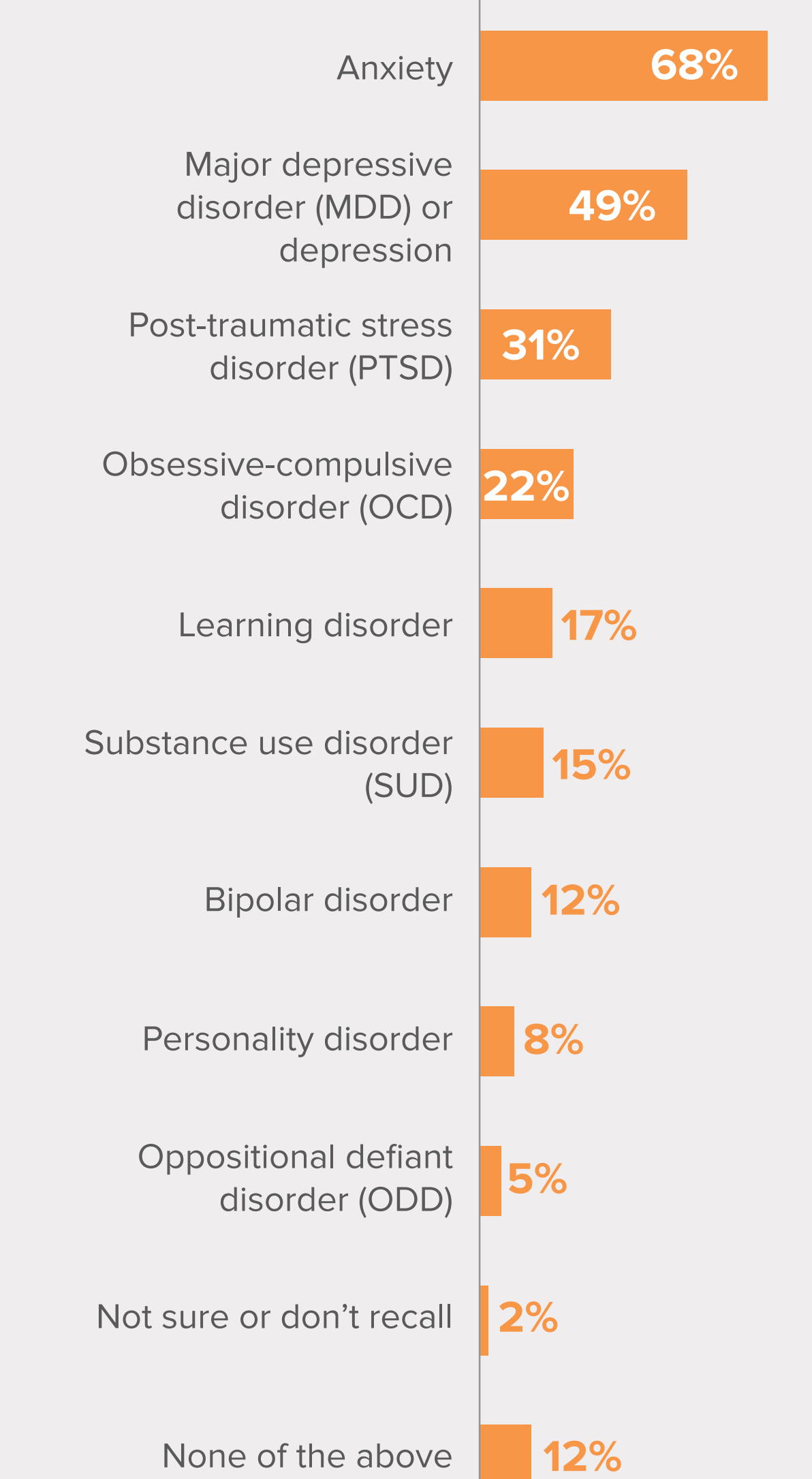
ADHD HAS A SIGNIFICANT IMPACT ON THE QUALITY OF LIFE OF PATIENTS.

This educational research study uncovered valuable insights into the patient/caregiver experience related to adult ADHD and identified gaps in care.

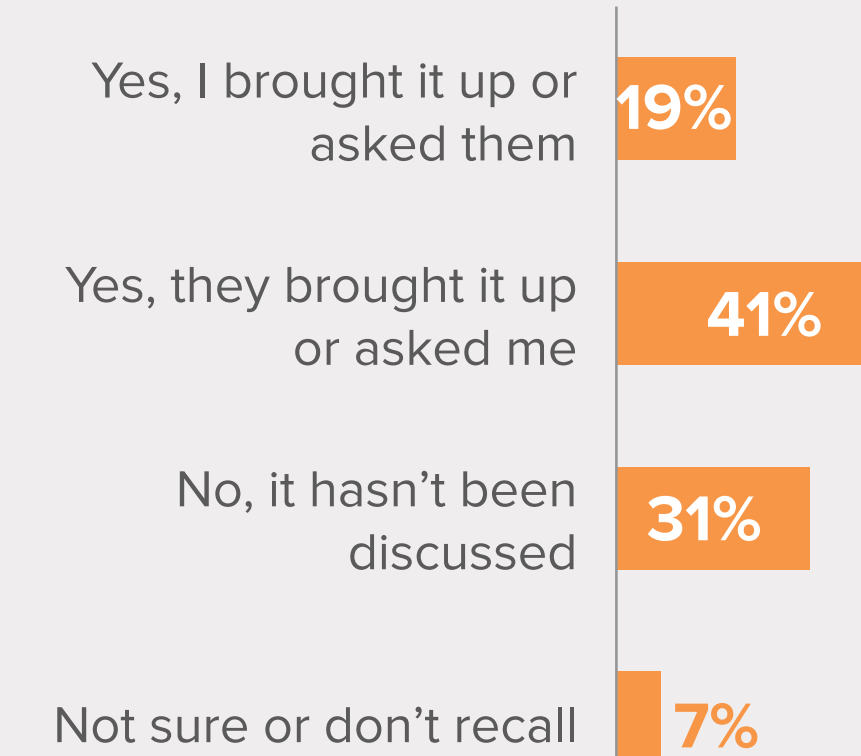

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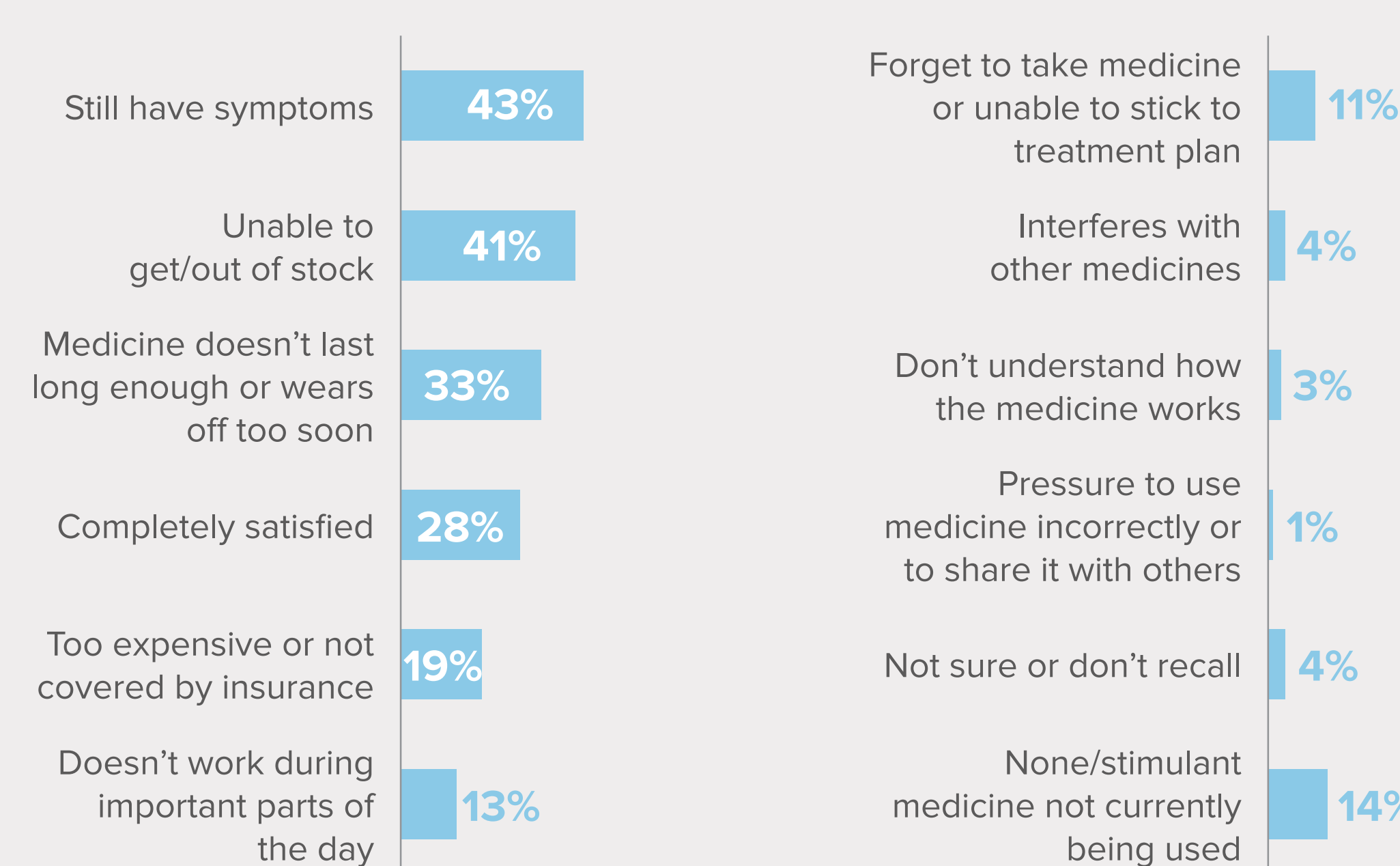

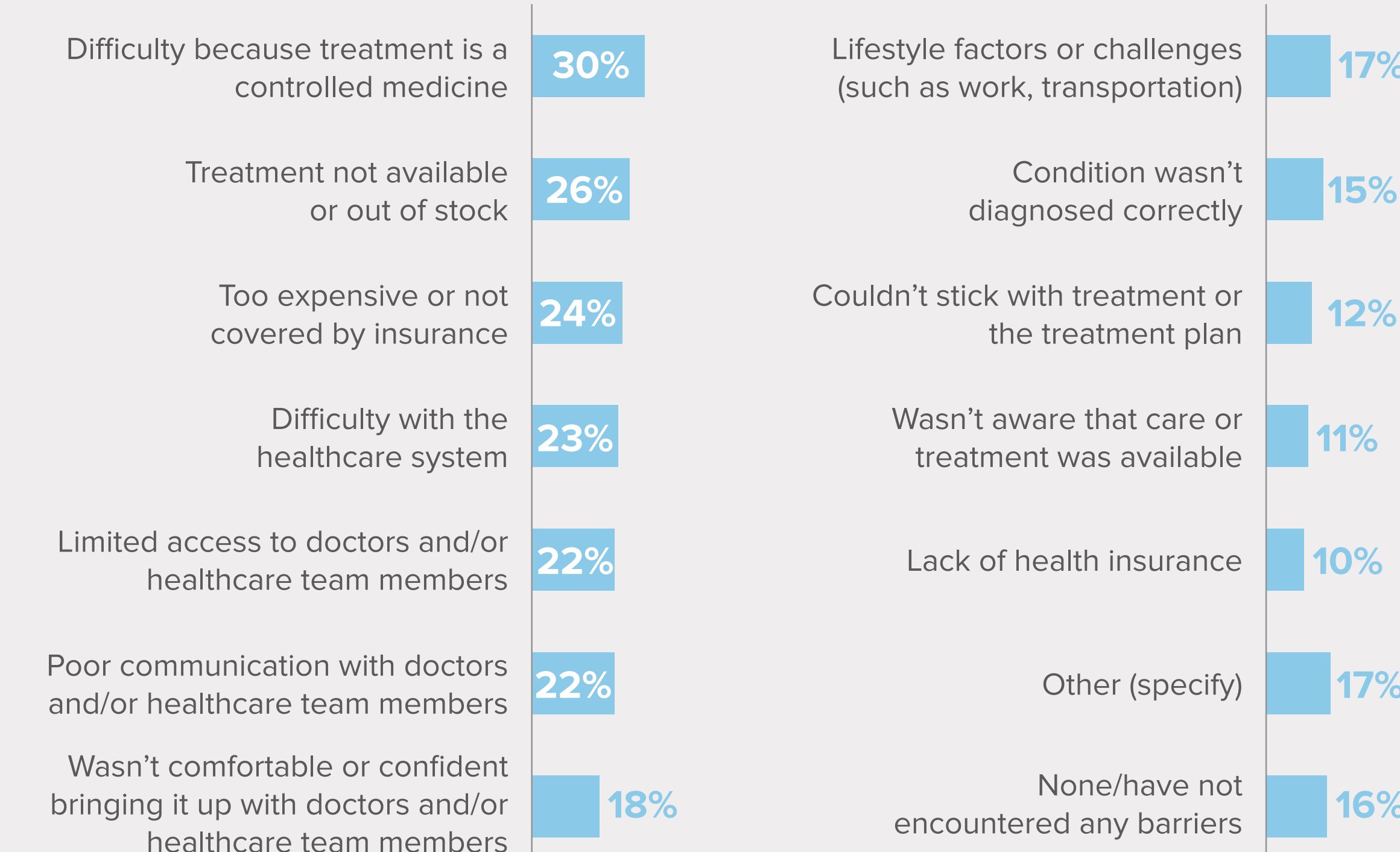
