Assessing Patient Perceptions in the Care of Adults With ADHD

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OBJECTIVE

To assess adult patient perspectives and experiences in the care of their attentiondeficit hyperactivity disorder (ADHD).



METHODS

A 20-question, online, patient-facing survey was deployed on WebMD.com. No personally identifiable information was collected for the respondents in this study. Initial data collection occurred from November 6, 2023 to November 10, 2023.



RESULTS


In total, 318 individuals completed the survey (92% diagnosed with adult ADHD). Majority of respondents had ADHD for more than 10 years and been on medication for more than 5 years.














CONCLUSIONS
