

Case Conversations in the Timely Recognition of Alzheimer's Disease: A Social Media Experience

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Target Audience and Goal Statement

This activity is intended for a global audience of neurologists, primary care physicians, geriatricians, nurse practitioners, and physician assistants who manage patients at risk of or diagnosed with Alzheimer's disease (AD) and their patients/caregivers.

The goal of this activity is for learners to be better able to discuss the importance of timely recognition of early-stage AD and the tools and assessments that can facilitate the diagnosis of early stages of AD.

Upon completion of this activity, participants will be able to:

- Identify patients who should be assessed for an early form of AD
- Select an appropriate clinical assessment for the timely identification of patients in an early stage of AD
